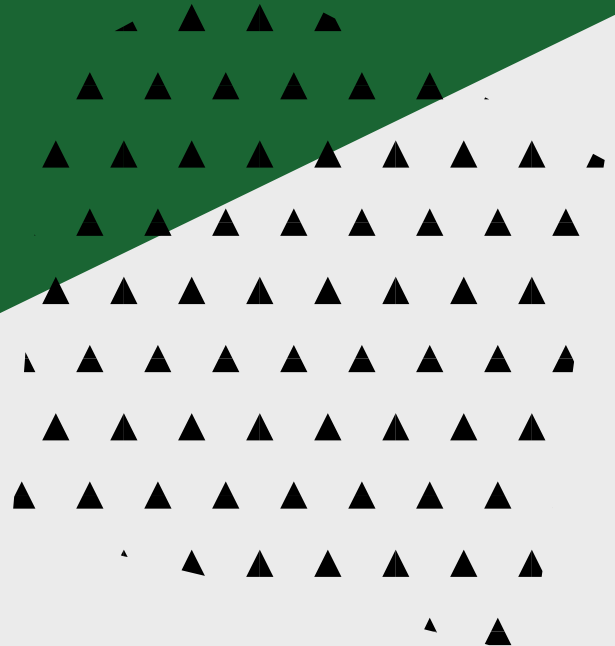

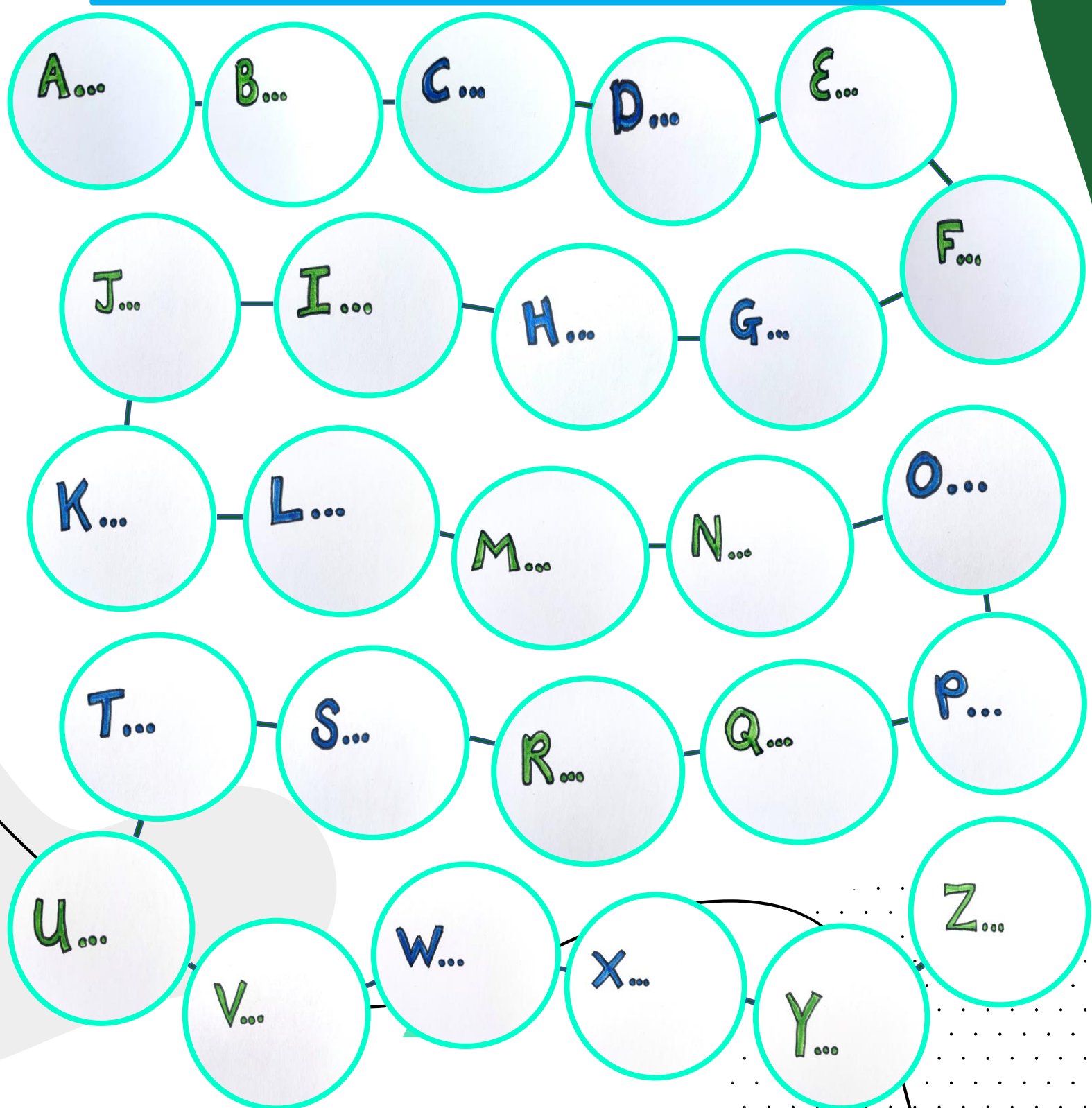




Unlocking Potential

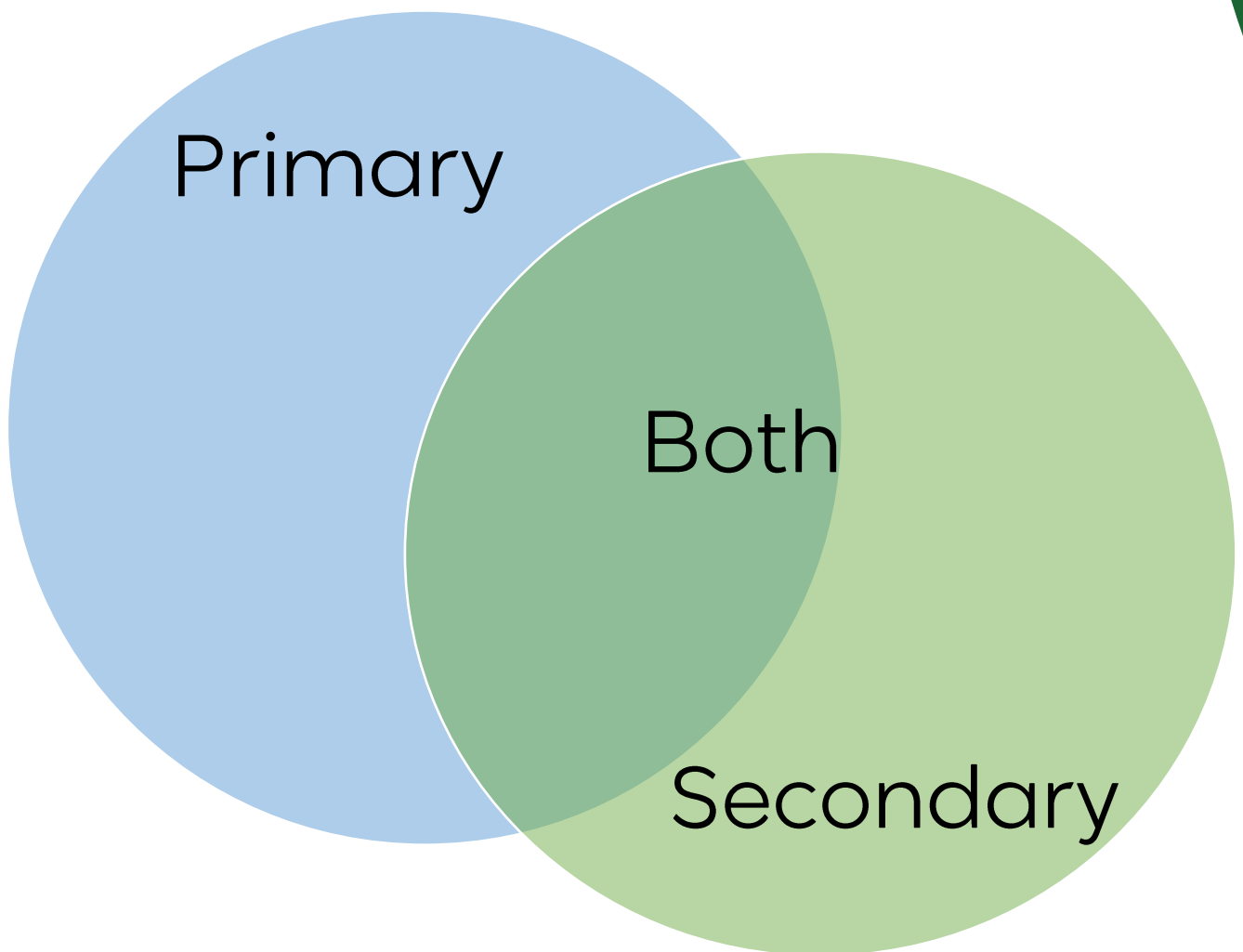
